BRASS AND GOLD settled off the pace, rallied three across on the turn, swung a bit wide entering the stretch, inched clear and held well. ENFORCER saved ground while close to the pace, awaited room on the turn, bid off the rail, went willingly to the wire but couldn't gain on the winner. TEANCUM vied two across to the second turn, fell back, continued willingly and held for show. K JS MADDOG raced in the middle of the pack, lacked the needed late response and failed to menace. OH MEXICO was unhurried early, advanced around the turn, bid four wide to get within striking distance and hung in the lane. BROADWAY ACT was outrun in an even effort. KING ROAR vied inside to the second turn, tired and gave way. FLEXIPLUS pulled up and walked off.
