**Footnotes**

RAINIER MISSILE drew clear early and moved inward, saved ground on the turn and drew off through the final furlong under intermittent urging. TRUCKIN tracked early, chased through the lane and held the place. COOPER'S STORM broke a bit awkwardly then forwardly placed, was four wide into the lane and needed more while clear of the rest. SPECTACULARTOP raced near the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response. DAVE'S PACEMAKER was just off the inside turning for home and between foes briefly inside the eighth pole, also lacked the needed response. BRADY BLUE EYES well placed early, chased three wide on the turn and weakened in the drive. CONTREVE raced near the inside turning for home and lacked a rally. FATHER JONES saved ground and lacked a stretch bid. DO WHAT U DARE came six wide to the stretch and offered little. POP THE CORK was four wide into the stretch and lacked a bid.
