**Footnotes**

VERY VEGAS broke in stride and drew off, was taken in hand midway on the backstretch, relaxed through the second turn, roused under mostly hand urging in the lane and held on under steady handling. COKE'S MELODY raced in the second flight between horses, went for the lead outside VERY VEGAS on the second turn, was slow to respond under a stern drive three wide in the lane but closed well and just missed. MUIR BEACH chased VERY VEGAS from inside, also made her move on the second turn, rallied belatedly just off the rail in the stretch, dueled with HOMEMAKER for third and got it late. HOMEMAKER was away slowly, settled off the rail, angled out four wide on the second turn to make her bid, had an easy striking position in the lane, tried hard to keep third while closing in the last eighth but did not have enough late. CHURCH EDITOR chased VERY VEGAS from outside, went for the lead three wide on the second, could not keep up leaving that bend, was angled outside HOMEMAKER going to the eighth pole and also found best stride too late. LIGHT GIVEN raced closest to VERY VEGAS from between horses, closed the gap on the second turn but flattened out the last quarter mile. The rider of COKE'S MELODY lodged a claim of foul alleging interference from VERY VEGAS on the second turn but after their review, the stewards made no change.
