**Footnotes**

IRISH WARRIOR settled between horses, was angled out nearing the second turn, rallied three wide under a stiff drive in the stretch and caught BLACK BART near the wire. BLACK BART raced closest to ROCK N ROSH, saved ground through the second turn, made his bid outside that one in the stretch, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth marker, was all out in the late going but narrowly outfinished in a game effort. ROCK N ROSH sprinted clear, set the pace in hand, was asked to run into the stretch, tried hard under right-handed pressure but wore down the last furlong. ARSEN settled inside through the early going, was swung out on the second turn and showed a willingness to run late outside the rest. FREEFOURINTERNET also unhurried through the early going, came four wide through the second turn, lodged a mild bid between horses and closed the gap late without improving his position. ROYAL LAKE allowed to settle inside, was taken off the rail into the second turn, provided a bid two wide to advance to the furlong marker in the stretch then leveled off. SUPERIORITY raced midpack outside, progressed three wide on the second turn but wore down between rivals in the stretch. OUR BEST MAN settled behind SUPERIORITY on the backstretch, saved ground through the second turn, was taken off the rail for the stretch run and flattened out between horses. CAPTURED was an early factor inside but gave way on the second turn.
