GOLDEN RATIO lodged a four wide bid on the turn and pressed the issue then finished gamely to prevail. SPARROW up close early, lodged a three wide bid on the turn and raced between rivals turning for home and finished gamely. PLEASANT GAL pressed the early issue, vied for the lead between rivals turning for home and battled into midstretch then weakened. BEAR'S TIGERETTE well placed while saving ground, moved out some for the drive and lacked the needed response. MARIBETH between rivals entering the turn, raced near the rail and lacked a rally. BROOKIEOFTHEYEAR trailed entering the turn and three wide into the lane, offered little in the drive. NATALIE ONE vied for the lead, saved ground and weakened in the drive.
