MICKEY ROCKS tracked early, lodged a bid on the final turn and battled through the lane then finished gamely to prevail. SMARTY FAWCETT saved ground while well placed, moved out for the drive, bumped with a rival passing the eighth pole then finished gamely while drifting out late despite right handed pressure. DEL MAR DRAMA set the pace, saved ground and yielded grudgingly. CASA O trailed early, advanced between rivals entering the far turn, was just off the rail into stretch, eased out some late and finished willingly. THE BARTON BOY well placed outside, raced in the four path entering the lane, was bumped passing the eighth pole then carried out late. BRAHMS INFERNO saved ground and lacked the needed stretch response. PERFECTIONISM raced outside, was five wide turning for home and lacked a rally. GOLDEN MIST well placed early and just off the inside, weakened on the final turn. S S STEWBALL was steadied entering the far turn then lacked a bid. Following a stewards inquiry and a claim of foul by the rider of THE BARTON BOY against SMARTY FAWCETT for stretch interference, the latter was disqualified from second and placed fifth.
