Footnotes

WONDER'S SENSATION vied to the second turn, inched away for a short lead, was under pressure late and held well in a driving finish. STAMP OF APPROVAL raced in the second flight, advanced between horses into the second turn, bid willingly, couldn't get by the winner and was all out for place. BEARS HOME RUN was unhurried early, went six wide at the top of the stretch, found his best stride late and was gaining fast. BALLET WAY was unhurried early, rallied off the rail entering the stretch and finished well. TONY THE PONY saved ground, was checked entering the turn, fell back, angled out, bid five wide and closed well under strong urging. TWO TURNS bumped slightly at the start, raced close to the pace, rallied four wide on the turn to loom a threat, tired and gave way. JACK ATTACK bumped slightly at the start, raced outside and stopped on the second turn. SWEET TIGGER was rated along the backstretch, vied inside to the second turn, tired and stopped.
