COME AWAY HOME well placed and three wide on the turn, raced in the four path entering the lane and finished well while drawing out late. SUPERCARLS REMEDY stumbled at the start, moved up in the run down the backstretch, reached the front on the turn and was no match late to the top one. OZILDA'S LAST SON fractious at the gate unseating the rider, was bumped and in tight between rivals leaving the gate then finished willingly along the rail. TIZ SEXY unseated the rider and was loose just briefly behind the gate, was brushed at the start and moved up to reach the front, saved ground and weakened in the drive. RAINIER MISSILE broke out some and steadied at the break, pulled and was steadied on the backstretch then was checked while along the rail entering the turn, moved off the inside and chased then tired in the drive. MISS ME YET chased through the early stages and tired.
