Footnotes

SPECTATION advanced between foes passing the quarter pole, came in crowding rivals nearing the eighth pole then finished gamely to prevail. ANDHERECOMESCJ broke slowly, moved up on the turn while just off the inside, angled to the rail for the drive, was bumped and steadied nearing the eighth pole then finished gamely inside. THUNDER ALI also broke slowly, lodged a five wide bid on the turn and chased then needed more. CEBURUCO set the pace inside, moved off the rail entering the lane, was between rivals when in tight and bumped nearing the furlong marker, dropped back and was angled out some then weakened in the drive. MARION'S JEWELL pressed the issue from between rivals and tired in the drive. MOON TAX saved ground and lacked a rally. STREAKIN COWBOY three deep to the turn, pressed the issue, moved five wide turning for home and tired. MOMENT OF INERTIA hesitated at the break coming out behind the field then was slow into stride dropping far back through the opening stages. Following a stewards inquiry and a claim of foul by the rider of CEBURUCO against SPECTATION for stretch interference, the latter was disqualified from first and placed fourth.
