BRIECAT set the pace from along the inside, drew clear in upper stretch then responded gamely while holding a rival safe to the wire. LA MINA well placed early, lodged a four wide bid nearing the top of the lane and finished willingly while unable to make up the needed late ground. KYLIE'S WAY pressed the early issue, raced between rivals turning for home and weakened in the drive. RAREVILLE saved ground entering the far turn, raced between foes turning for home and lacked the needed rally. BITTERBUTSWEET never far back, raced three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. GINNY'S PIG broke in, saved ground and lacked a bid. PURE AND SIMPLE broke awkwardly, moved up early and prompted the issue three deep, moved closer nearing the quarter pole and tired in the drive. LA MISMA lacked a rally.
