SOLID GLITTER just a bit reluctant loading, drew clear early, was rated into the lane then drew out under mild hand urging. ISLAND DRUMS moved inside on the turn and finished willingly while second best. CADET BLUE well placed three wide, was asked on the turn and lacked the needed response. BARBARIC outside on the turn, raced four wide passing the quarter pole and lacked the needed stretch bid. POINT OF ORIGIN chased and weakened in the drive. BRITE SHADOW raced near the inside on the turn and lacked a rally. WORKMATE broke just a bit awkwardly, raced three wide into the turn and lacked a rally. BLACK ROCK BURNER saved ground and lacked a bid.
