ROSIANA raced just off the inside on the turn, moved to the front in upper stretch and drew clear under vigorous hand urging. TULELAKE moved to a narrow advantage along the inside on the turn then continued on willingly while no match to the top one. BROOKTON saved ground and was steadied briefly nearing the lane then gained a share. CASINO KAY pressed early and three wide on the turn, raced four wide into the lane and lacked the needed stretch response. CASCABEL LADY broke out some, saved ground and lacked a rally. JANS QUEEN bumped at the start, trailed to the lane and lacked a bid. PISTOIA vied for the early lead off the inside, raced between rivals on the turn, was in the three path entering the lane and tired. PITUFA raced near the rail on the turn and lacked a response.
