Footnotes

WHERE'S THE REMOTE a bit headstrong early along the inside, raced up close while saving ground, moved three wide lodging a bid passing the quarter pole, chased through the lane and finished gamely to prevail. ZENARO vied for the lead outside a rival, responded gamely through the stretch run then could not quite match the top one at the wire. GENTLE AS A BREEZE saved ground to the lane then finished willingly between foes. LESSON IN DECEIT vied for command along the inside, battled through the lane then yielded late. FLY'N LION bumped leaving the gate, raced just off the inside turning for home and needed more. ARRAIGNMENT bumped leaving the gate, was four wide into the lane and lacked a stretch bid. PASTERO three wide into the far turn, was five wide into the lane and had no rally. MASTER DEMAND raced well placed into the far turn and weakened.
