Footnotes

CAPITANO, reserved near the inside from early on, went along under patient handling, worked her way forward between horses three or four wide on the far turn, continued between foes into the lane, was alertly angled to rail to go after front-running AZA leaving the furlong grounds, then proved gamely best under urging. WESTERN ACT, in front briefly during the early going while inside, allowed the lead to AZA, remained near the inside, lost position on the far turn, was asked for her best at the five-sixteenth pole, eased out five wide into the stretch, loomed boldly but was outfinished. AZA contested the pace from early on while outside of WESTERN ACT, gained a slight edge, went along under careful handling three or four wide, was clear for the final furlong but couldn't last. PRORUNNER gained a forward position while between horses four wide early, tracked front-running AZA into the final furlong and was empty when the test came. MODERN ERA (AUS), nicely positioned from the outset while near the inside, lost a bit of position about the five-sixteenths pole, continued inside but lacked a closing account. COURTLY JAZZ settled three wide early, raced between horses around the far turn four or five wide, then failed to fire. PLUM RED outrun from the start and racing near the inside most of the way, wasn't a factor. SAINT CHRISJON stalked the pace four or five wide to the stretch and tired. ALOTTADAR never menaced.
