Footnotes

BIG MAX moved up between horses to vie to the turn, inched away for a short lead, was under pressure through the stretch and held well in a driving finish. THECATCHCHECKRAISED bumped at the start, set the pace around the first turn, vied inside to the second turn, fell back, angled out in the upper stretch, continued willingly to the wire but couldn't gain ground. MELLO NELLO bumped at the start, was checked on the first turn, saved ground while close to the pace and earned show in a steady effort. CLURIOSITY raced close to the pace in a wide trip and flattened out. WINNERSTORM pressed the pace, was through after a half and dropped back. GELFAND had brief speed only and did not threaten. SIRIUS STAR raced wide and was not a factor.
