SLEW'S BOY well placed early, advanced three wide on the turn, reached the front in the stretch and finished gamely to prevail. TRIP THE GENERAL lodged a bid outside on the turn, raced in the four path into the lane and finished gamely. LORD AVALON trailed into the turn, raced off the inside turning for home and finished willingly while needing more. GOIN' DANCIN set the pace inside, raced in the two path entering the stretch and weakened in the drive. GATWICK three deep to the turn, chased and tired in the drive. BONBONI never far back, saved ground and lacked the needed bid. LADNER LAD pressed early from between rivals, raced near the inside on the turn and weakened. CHARTERHILL raced near the rail on the turn and lacked a response.
