KUYA up close early and outside into the turn, challenged for the lead on the bend and dueled for command turning for home and through the lane then won a head bobbing decision. FREE ACTION set the pace inside, dueled through the stretch then just missed. BOLD MEETING raced three wide turning for home and lacked the needed late response. FLAMING GLORY between rivals into the turn, chased and weakened in the drive. ONE VOTE pressed early between rivals, was near the inside on the turn and lacked the needed stretch response. VISION OF ROSES raced five wide turning for home and lacked a rally. OUACHITA CREEK saved ground and lacked the needed response. TWO ONE GUN between rivals early, raced four wide turning for home and tired.
