MYMOTHERMARGE vied early then saved ground while prompting the issue, continued to save ground to the lane and battled for command through the stretch and finished gamely to prevail. SOPRANO SECTION settled just off the early leaders, advanced to the front three wide nearing the quarter pole and continued on gamely. ACCOUNTABLE DIVA never far back while saving ground, lodged a four wide bid on the final turn and needed more late. SEATTLE COUNTDOWN had the rider lose the whip early, eased out in upper stretch and offered a mild gain. JO'S FINALE vied for the early lead outside a rival, was between foes passing the quarter pole and weakened in the drive. BURNING PARIS raced near the inside and lacked the needed response. SPENDING TIME was outside to the far turn, raced wide passing the quarter pole and was eased up briefly dropping back.
