Footnotes

MAGNIFICENT VAL stalked the pace from outside, went for the lead three wide on the second turn, drew clear under mostly hand urging in the lane and continued to lengthen her lead under a drive in the late going. FANZOCA steadily progressed between horses to threaten four wide on the second turn, took over second into the stretch, gave futile chase in the lane and lugged in late. MOONLIT MADDIE settled outside, picked up her pace after a half mile, split rivals four wide into the second turn, lost ground fanning out six wide into the lane, had an easily striking position midstretch, finished evenly but took over third. MAJOR IDEA waited for room through the early going, advanced three wide between rivals on the second turn, made a bid inside MAGNIFICENT VAL in the stretch, had every chance a furlong out but wore down late. COLOR ME FAST gradually backed up between rivals, was swung out on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and passed tired ones. SILK N DIAMONDS pressed MISS PIXIE from outside to the middle of the second turn then gave way between rivals. HARBOR BLUES in contention briefly, gradually backed up racing widest of all and had little left the last quarter mile. MISS PIXIE showed first, set the pace just off the rail to the second turn but faltered leaving that bend and faded between horses. IMPERATRIZ RAFAELA (BRZ) showed little staying well off the rail. ASPEN HILL was well placed inside to the second turn but gave way the last quarter mile. DARTING DOT soon trailed inside, was swung out leaving the second turn but had nothing to offer in the lane.
