TRIBAL WARRIOR drew clear midway down the backstretch, was rated into the lane then responded when asked and drew out. MEMO TO MYA chased on the turn, drifted in passing the eighth pole then held the place. VALLEY STATION saved ground to the lane then gained some late. BLUE 'EM AWAY (IRE) outside into the turn, raced in the four path entering the stretch and lacked the needed response. MAJOR BRASS up close early and near the rail on the turn, raced three wide into the lane and tired.
