DESERT TRAIN pressed the pace, assumed command entering the stretch, drew clear and extended his lead under mild urging. PRAY TO WIN bumped and was crowded at the start, was taken outside, set the pace to the turn, couldn't keep up with the winner but held for place. CERTAINLY CERTAIN raced close to the pace, went four wide entering the stretch, failed to rally but was best of the rest. I'MARAINBOWRIDER broke awkwardly and bumped at the start, saved ground and lacked a bid. TREE TOP showed brief speed while racing outside and steadily faded from contention. IMA RAISIN KANE broke out and bumped at the start, was steadied along the rail on the backstretch, was taken outside, bore out on the turn and dropped back.
