SEARCHFORTHETRUTH saved ground to the lane, spilt rivals a furlong out and drew clear. TONIGHT AT ELEVEN vied early then prompted the pace inside, regained the advantage in the stretch and continued on willingly to the wire. CLAY W. WOODSTOCK saved ground while well placed, was angled out for the drive and loomed a threat then needed more. OCONEE vied for the lead outside a rival, drifted out slightly into the lane and weakened in the drive. CLASS FIVE RAPID lodged a three wide bid on the final turn and lacked the needed stretch response. MUQS QUEST trailed into the far turn, saved ground and lacked a rally. SOLO PERFORMANCE raced forwardly placed to the far turn and weakened then was not urged through the lane.
