DIAMOND DAN stalked the pace while racing outside, went five wide leaving the turn, closed steadily and got up near the wire. ENGINE SIXTY NINE pressed the pace inside, was steadied on the turn awaiting room, got through along the rail, dueled through the stretch and was outnoddod to just miss. EDMOND set a pressured pace, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. HOPETOWN HERO trailed the field, went seven wide in the drive, found his best stride late and was gaining ground. PRARIE FALCON raced close to the pace, went four wide entering the lane, was boxed in and blocked through the upper and mid stretch and lost his chance. MAROZI pressed the pace three across, dueled past the eighth pole and was unable to sustain his bid. KBELLO was never far back, failed to rally and was not a threat.
