Footnotes

SIMPLY DAZZLING broke out, prompted the early issue and moved to the front on the turn, drew out into midstretch then maintained a safe margin. SPOKANE DANCER forced out some at the start, moved four wide for the drive and finished willingly while second best. OUT OF HARBOR well placed early inside, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn and weakened in the drive. ADVICE TO SINNERS broke out, saved ground into the far turn and lacked a late response. FINLEY set the early pace, saved ground and weakened in the drive. ALOTTA WILD raced six wide into the lane and lacked a rally. PATPEGBERN a bit rank early, trailed and lacked a bid. MIDNIGHT DREAMIN lunged out at the start to be away awkwardly, raced well placed and lacked the needed response then tired in the drive.
