HAYDEN LAKE drew clear early, showed the way to the lane and responded to pressure while remaining well clear. IN LARRY WE TRUST chased and finished willingly while holding the place. DR MACKEE broke outward, raced four wide into the turn and chased on the turn then lacked the needed late response. ELUSIVE CHIEF forced out at the start, raced wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. REARIN UP READY fractious briefly in the gate, raced near the rail on the turn and lacked a rally. BLACK TURN raced between rivals into the turn and lacked the needed response. BRITE BELLE saved ground and lacked a bid. JACKS THE LAW bobbled at the start and between foes entering the turn, weakened through the lane then was vanned off.
