Footnotes

WOLFGANG just off the inside into the far turn, raced four wide into the lane and closed well to prevail. KICK ROCKS prompted the early issue, raced between rivals and vied for command turning for home and continued on gamely to the wire. WESTERN STRIDER four wide early, vied for the lead three deep, raced in the four path into the stretch and battled gamely to the end. ACOLYTE four wide early, raced five wide into the lane and was gaining well late. MAJOR MADAGAN bumped at the start, raced just off the inside on the final turn and lacked a rally. EPICURUS bobbed at the start, vied from along the inside and weakened in the drive. ROB THE MOMENT bobbed at the break, raced well placed to the lane and tired. IRISH SNOWFALL bumped with a rival at the break, saved ground into the far turn, moved out and lacked a rally.
