Footnotes

EXCESSIVE YODELER raced close to the pace while saving ground, awaited room on the turn, bid off the rail, assumed command near the sixteenth pole and drew off. CARNERA was unhurried early while saving ground, advanced along the rail to the second turn, awaited room, got through inside, closed well and got up late for place. ST PATRICKS APPEAL set a pressured pace to late stretch and was unable to sustain his bid. SWISS EXPLOIT stalked the pace while racing between horses, was taken back into the turn, came again and closed through traffic. MILITARY DEPUTY lagged early, went seven wide leaving the turn and finished well. JAMES was steadied into the first turn, pressed the pace two wide to the second turn and tired. BEAR FAMOUS TRIP stalked outside, advanced to the turn to loom a threat, tired and gave way. FOX IN THE HOUSE stalked the pace between horses to the turn, flattened out and faded through the stretch. JETHRO was slow early, went six wide leaving the turn and lacked a bid.
