Footnotes

JUNE'S PRINCE alternated for the lead to the stretch, drew clear in upper stretch and widened briefly then held safe a late challenger at the wire. FORCE OF POWER vied for the early lead while three deep then dropped back some into the turn, was three deep into the stretch and was gaining late. OBSTRUCTION raced three deep nearing the quarter pole, came five wide for the drive and lacked a solid bid. KEN FRIEND (BRZ) alternated on the lead to the stretch then drifted out in the final sixteenth under left-handed urging while tiring. WINEWOMENANDSONG was bumped at the break then settled off the leaders and was not a serious threat. COMMANDER PERRY was also bumped at the break, took the three path on the turn and didn't seriously threaten. WILD HOUSTON raced inside and lacked a bid. SPORTY MCGEE showed brief speed down the backstretch, took the three path on the turn and weakened. ANY ONE WISH was just off the leaders from along the rail into the turn, stayed inside for the stretch and tired. WALL STREET WALLY had a six to eight-wide trip and was not a factor. NUMEROUS XS settled well off the leaders down the backstretch, was four wide into the stretch and not a factor. SONNYS BIG BISCUIT (IRE) was close to the leaders into the turn, raced five wide on the turn and six wide into the stretch then tired.
