KINGSVILLE moved toward the rail into the clubhouse turn, was shifted out on the backstretch, advanced on the final turn and raced between rivals while challenging for the lead nearing the quarter pole, reached the front in the lane and finished well while drawing clear. HEZAMAZING in closest attendance early, saved ground into the far turn and was unable to maintain his position, raced near the inside into the lane and spilt foes late while gamely earning the place. NIKKI'SGOLDENSTEED a bit sluggish at the start and four wide into the clubhouse turn, advanced outside on the final bend and challenged for the lead three deep passing the quarter pole then could not sustain the needed momentum. TENFOLD drew well clear on the first turn and widened on the backstretch, was given a breather on the final turn, saved ground and weakened in the drive. TRIP THE GENERAL lacked a rally. R E O SPEEDDRAGON three wide early, lacked a response.
