JOE BLACK SANDY set the pace around the first turn, vied inside, dueled through the stretch and proved best. WESTERN TWIST pressed the pace, moved up to vie two wide along the backstretch, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. TRIBAL ONE stalked the pace inside, angled out in the upper stretch, closed well and was gaining ground. RENEGADE CIELO raced mid pack, bid inside entering the stretch, found his best stride late and was gaining ground. HUG THIS CHULLO was never far back, had nothing left for the drive and hung. GARY THE GORILLA fell far back early, offered a mild bid only and was outrun. DISTORTED SKY fell far back early, went wide in the drive and was never a factor. COURTING SEATTLE was never far back, got through along the rail on the turn, had nothing left and faded. I BEAT THE FIRE was outrun. TYMAKER was not urged and distanced the field.
