LOOKN MIGHTY TUFF lagged outside, rallied around the turn, closed steadily and got up late. POPULAR NAME saved ground while close to the pace, bid between horses on the turn, assumed command, drew clear, led to deep stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. HE WHO LAUGHS LAST was unhurried early, fell far back to trail, rallied six wide leaving the turn, found his best stride late and was gaining ground. SAN GIUSEPPE raced close to the pace, rallied three across on the turn to loom a threat, tired and gave way. HE'S STYLIN' drew clear on the first turn, set the pace to the second turn, tired and gave way.
