### Footnotes

A TEAM LEADER prompted the early issue, moved to the front nearing the quarter pole and edged clear late then held to the wire. BANKER'S D LIGHT five wide into the turn, raced six wide into the stretch and finished willingly. BUKAHU saved ground to the lane and finished willingly while not good enough. PIVOT PAD set the pace inside and battled into midstretch then weakened late. CLAIM THE THRONE between rivals into the turn, had the rider lose the whip, raced near the inside and lacked the needed bid. TRAFFIC UPDATE moved out on the backstretch, raced five wide and lacked a rally. CHAUNCEY well placed early and near the inside on the turn, lacked the needed response. DASHBOARD DRUMMER lacked a rally. FOR DADDY saved ground and lacked a bid. REBUCK raced four wide into the turn and weakened through the lane. SERVER lacked a rally.
