CHASE RED stalked the pace, went three wide entering the stretch, closed willingly to get up the final strides and was all out at the wire. DE SICA broke a bit slowly, was unhurried while racing outside, went seven wide entering the stretch, closed well, was gaining and was outnodded to just miss. EXPERT THIS set the pace, drew off on the turn for a clear lead, led to the final strides and was outfinished. BUCK'S BULL broke awkwardly, lagged early and finished well to narrow the gap. FIRE TALKER raced in the middle of the pack, went six wide entering the stretch and finished well. ROZYS SCENARIO was steadied at the start, saved ground, went five wide into the stretch and offered a mild bid only. ROCKY RASCAL saved ground, bid along the rail on the turn to loom a threat and hung. REXBURG pressed the pace to the turn and flattened out.
