Footnotes

RUSSELLETTE broke inward, bumping ISLAND DEVA, was hustled along to stay close between rivals, floated out some into the stretch, rallied from the three-path to gain the lead a sixteenth of a mile from the finish and was driven clear. ISLAND DEVA pinched between horses at the start, raced in the second flight on the backstretch, failed to keep up three wide on the bend and rallied belatedly outside RUSSELLETTE in the stretch to gain second in the waning yards. SCHMOOEY midpack inside on the backstretch, was swung out on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and also found best stride too late. JOETTA also bumped with ISLAND DEVA at the start, backed up four wide on the turn, lost further ground fanning out six wide for the stretch run but closed with a rush and just missed third. STREAMLINE GAHL broke in stride, set the pace inside but wore down inside the final furlong. WALK WEST fractious in the gate before the start, stayed well off the rail from the early going, took the turn five wide, was angled in behind ISLAND DEVA for the stretch run and passed tired ones late. IAM ALL PUMPED UP raced closest to STREAMLINE GAHL, saved ground through the turn, wore down in the lane and was angled outside the latter in the late going. ROYAL TWISTER void of speed inside, was angled out three wide in the stretch, made up minor ground late but was outfinished. DIAMOND ICE was soon far back while well off the rail, angled in on the turn, showed late interest three wide and was altered in to the rail for a clear path nearing the wire.
