### Footnotes

PORTHCAWL (GB), under light restraint early, pressed front-running SOCIETY CAT three or four wide, headed that one just prior to going six furlongs, then was fully extended to hold sway under hand urging. After being pulled up on the backstretch, PORTHCAWL (GB) was vanned off. MUIR BEACH, well placed inside from the outset, worked her way out four or five wide nearing the sixteenth pole and was slowly getting to the winner at the end. SOCIETY CAT gained the lead near the inside early, edged clear while in hand, lost the advantage to the winner just prior to going three-quarters, then held on stubbornly the remainder. MADISON MEADOWS, near the inside and never far back, eased out a bit to advance from between foes into the lane, loomed a solid threat but came up empty at the end. SPARKLING HUMOR tracked the pace four wide to the stretch and tired. OPAL'S SONG was outrun.
