Footnotes

HANGONSLEWPHYHANGON stalked the contested pace while rated wide and clear, closed up strongly around the turn, came to speed rivals belatedly at the quarter mile mark, responded well as the best horse in the drive, and drew off through the stretch well in hand. THATSUSINTEOLBEAN placed forwardly from the outset, closed up along the inside nearing the five sixteenths pole, rallied sharply on the rail to the lane, and finished gamely to the wire. G MALLEAH vied on the lead from the start, assumed command through the turn, bore out coming to the stretch to be six wide, and finished evenly in mid track while posting a strong effort. IZA REDHEAD stalked the pace to the outside, came wide off the turn, then went evenly through the stretch. ABSOLUTE APPEAL raced evenly throughout. JOMAX rated in mid pack, dropped in around the turn, and offered a mild rally between horses in the drive to the wire. COMPENSATE dropped back at the start, raced along the inside throughout, and closed ground moderately in the stretch. BETTER CHOICE off well at the start, vied on the lead between rivals, gave way after the half, and was tired in the stretch. GENERALLY ON showed little, but managed to pass tired horses in the stretch. EMAILIT was no factor. BRASS AMBASSADOR vied for the lead to the turn, then gave way between horses and retreated.
