Footnotes

SHRAPNEL raced inside, vied throughout and proved best. MALIBU PROSPECT bobbled and bumped at the start, was hustled along to vie outside and was outfinished in a game effort. MACHO IRISH was unhurried early while saving ground, eased out for the drive, closed with a rush and was gaining fast late. RACE WARRIOR bumped at the start, vied between horses to the final strides and yielded grudgingly. SILK CREEK vied between horses early, fell back, went wide in the drive and lacked the needed late rally. ENERGETIC LOVER vied between horses, had the rider check entering the turn and dropped back. SCARY MIDNIGHT raced outside and lacked a bid. DARLIN MCKENNA was unhurried early, dropped inside to save ground and failed to respond. UTAH BEACH vied between horses, had the rider check entering the turn, dropped back and was not urged late. Following a rider's objection, ENERGETIC LOVER was disqualified and placed ninth for causing interference entering the turn.
