LOVINTHELMELIGHT drew clear early and showed the way to the lane, widened under steady hand urging then was not seriously threatened. GAME SEVEN trailed into the lane then offered a late gain along the rail and earned the place. MASTER DEMAND up close off the inside, chased through the lane and lacked the needed late response. PLAY N WIN up close and near the rail on the turn, weakened in the drive. BRUDDA CLYDE between rivals on the turn, lacked the needed bid. NOTIS SAL broke a bit slowly, moved up three wide into the turn, was in the four path turning for home and lacked a stretch bid. ULTIMATE DECISION saved ground and lacked a rally.
