SECRET SPY a bit reluctant loading, advanced three wide turning for home and reached the front passing the sixteenth pole then responded gamely while holding off a rival. WED TOO QUICK lunged out while showing in front at the break then dropped back, raced four wide turning for home and finished gamely. GONE DIGITAL three deep early, prompted the issue rounding the turn outside a rival, reached the front in upper stretch then was not good enough. FACE YOUR FEAR near the rail on the turn, eased out slightly entering the lane and offered a late gain. TRIBAL TALKER raced five wide turning for home and offered a belated gain. WILD WINGS saved ground to the lane and lacked the needed response. FENWAY set the pace and weakened in the drive. SHU BIZ DANNY chased early inside, moved off the rail on the turn and weakened. GLOBAL STORM lacked a rally.
