Footnotes

FLEXIPLUS was unhurried early while racing outside, advanced to the turn, eased out at the top of the stretch, closed steadily and got up in the final strides. TEANCUM bumped at the start, raced close to the pace while saving ground, awaited room on the turn, bid between horses, inched away near the sixteenth pole and was caught late. OH MEXICO drew clear along the backstretch, responded when challenged to duel, faltered near the sixteenth pole and just lasted for show. K JS MADDOG bumped at the start, steadied slightly in tight quarters early, raced inside, bid willingly, didn't have enough late and was outnodded for third. ENFORCER was never far back, went seven wide leaving the turn, bid but didn't have enough late. TITLED NOBILITY bobbled at the start, pressed the pace while racing outside, rallied four wide on the turn to loom a threat, swung wide, fell back, tired and faded through the stretch. WAR TRADER set a pressured pace around the first turn, fell back along the backstretch, advanced to the second turn, tired and stopped.
