ZAWINNER rated off the battling leaders, came four wide into the stretch to lodge his bid in upper stretch then drove clear the final furlong. FIREMAN'S RIDE raced inside into the turn, was taken off the rail and was five wide moving into contention on the turn, was six wide into the stretch and finished well to be second best. VIDAL vied for the lead between foes into the stretch, responded briefly then weakened late. FOREST CREEK vied for the lead while three deep to mid-stretch, responded then tired the final sixteenth. RYAN'S NIGHT TRAIN joined the leaders to duel for command from along the rail nearing the half-mile marker, stayed in contention to upper stretch then tired. COPPER PROSPECTOR bobbled at the break then was not a factor while four wide into the stretch. PISA GOLD lagged shortly after the start and was never a factor. AKINTOWIN was in tight quarters and steadied briefly midway down the chute after the start, raced five wide into the turn and tired.
