Footnotes

CAPITANO was a bit fractious in the gate before the start, moved to the rail and saved ground to the stretch, eased out 3-deep and lodged his bid a furlong out and was up in time along the inside. CERVELO was rated while close up to the stretch, lodged a three-wide bid near the quarter pole, took a clear lead a furlong out then just failed to last. NIGHT DASH was in good position down the backstretch, edged up into the far turn, came four wide for the drive and finished willingly. MAMBO TRAIN was just off the leaders along the rail to the stretch, eased out for room at the top of the stretch, split foes but wasn't good enough. PLENTY OF HEAT raced between rivals into the far turn while four wide, was five wide into the drive then lacked a solid bid. WAIT IN LINE vied for the lead into the first turn, took a short advantage and maintained that to the stretch, responded then weakened the final furlong. WILD BUDDY settled in the middle of the pack, dropped back some into the far turn, was five wide near the quarter pole then lacked any stretch bid. HEY SLICK moved to the rail into the first turn, stayed inside throughout and never seriously threatened. TRAIL THIS was slow to load then vied for the lead to mid-stretch and tired.
