GREDELLE unhurried early, closed up through the final turn, engaged the leaders entering the stretch, and drew clear in the final eighth. NORTHERN JESTIC stalked the leader in hand, challenged that rival near the five sixteenth pole, took the lead entering the stretch, led to the eighth pole, but was outfinished by the winner. BIG SISTER led the field through moderate early fractions, was challenged midway through the final turn, lost the lead entering the stretch, battled gamely to deep stretch, and easily held the show. MODEL K reluctant to load, was rated mid pack while saving ground, improved position slightly in the stretch, but failed to impact the top three finishers. STICK N STEIN up close early, was well placed into the stretch, but went evenly. BORN TO DELIVER trailed the field early, was well back into the stretch, and was never a factor. AMBITIOUS BEACH void of speed, saved ground the entire trip to no avail. SISTER FRANCESCA rated well off the rail, failed to menace, and was always outrun.
