Footnotes

THE KINDED broke best from the gate, was allowed to settle for a half mile, rallied sharply to close up along the outside at mid turn, bid five wide to take the lead at the head of the stretch, then raced clear in the final furlong driving. CHANGEFORAFIFTY stalked the pace for a half mile, closed up willingly to challenge, lacked room late in the turn, angled out once straightened for the drive, came second at the eighth pole, then chased the winner evenly to the wire. DEDUCTED held off the pace for a half mile, closed up late in the turn, angled five wide to the stretch, then rallied to gain third and race clear for that position. AMSTERDAM (MEX) dropped off the pace at the outset, closed up six wide leaving the turn, and posted a good effort in the final furlong. YARRA (MEX) pressed the pace along the outside for five eighths of a mile, but weakened in the last furlong to the line. GAITER GIRL improved position moderately through the drive. VICTORY AFFAIR set the pace for a half mile, held a striking position at the furlong marker, but came up empty thereon to the wire. TONI Z loomed close to the pace from the rail for a half mile, but faded nearing the top of the lane. I DREAM OF RIO was no factor.
