TOTAL FABRICATION moved up along the rail nearing the half mile pole, battled for command from there and finished gamely to prevail while being bumped late. STARRY STRIVE pulled in the run down the backstretch and raced rank briefly, raced three wide into the far turn and moved to a narrow advantage on the final turn, raced head and head with a foe then missed while bumping the top one late. TIMOTHY WOOD saved ground into the far turn, chased along the inside through the lane and lacked the needed late response. CALL FOR JUSTICE lunged out to be away slowly, raced four wide to the far turn and had little left entering the lane. DIAMOND THUNDER raced four wide into the far turn and lacked a bid. PRAIRIE BOUND set the early pace just off the inside, was between rivals into the far turn and weakened. COY BOY HANSUM TOY failed to menace.
