TWO VIOLINS raced three across to the turn, bid four wide at the top of the lane, closed steadily and got up in the final strides. HEIR JOE was slow early, went five wide into the stretch, found his best stride late, was gaining fast and just missed at the wire. CALL ME JONES stalked inside, fell back on the turn, came again along the rail, got the lead briefly late and was outfinished in a game effort. SUPERCABRAS raced between horses to the turn, stalked the pace, bid willingly and was outfinished. RAINIER MISSILE was hustled along to set the pace, led to deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. NO IT AIN'T raced in the back, put in a steady effort and narrowed the gap. CLEAR TO CANADA trailed the field.
