TEJANO TROUBLE lunged out at the break, raced outside into the far turn, was angled inward to the three path into the lane and responded to urging while drawing clear late. ROGUE RIVER vied for the lead into the clubhouse turn from along the rail,then settled just off the leaders and moved out on the backstretch, lodged a bid on the final turn and drifted wide into the lane then gained some late to share runner-up honors. DARL'S GEM three wide into the first turn, vied for the lead, drew clear on the final turn and yielded in the drive while sharing the place spot. HAMONIC MOTION raced outside, was five wide turning for home and lacked the needed late response. TWO POINT TONY moved off the inside on the final turn and lacked the needed rally. ECKSTEIN raced well placed into the far turn and weakened. SANQUINE between rivals into the clubhouse turn, vied for the lead down the backstretch outside a rival and weakened on the final turn.
