

ASPEN HILL stalked the pace from outside, made her move while angling in some nearing the second turn, quickly drew clear, was under a drive through the stretch and held sway. COLOR ME FAST settled off the rail, advanced between rivals into the second turn, came three wide into the stretch, was gradually altered out to stay clear of NO TURBULENCE in the lane, overtook that one late and was closing in on ASPEN HILL late. NO TURBULENCE was kept close inside, was checked back when her path was taken nearing the second turn, altered out three wide at that point, gained second three wide on that bend but drifted out weakening. FOOL'S MATE progressed inside to reach contention on the backstretch but could not keep up leaving the second turn and made up only minor ground late. PRINCESS FOREVER pressed the pace from outside, did not keep up four wide through the second turn and continued to weaken while being altered out to stay clear of COLOR ME FAST in the lane. DARTING DOT was hustled along under an early whip, set the pace off the rail, was moved to the rail nearing the second turn and faded after that. SILK N DIAMONDS somewhat rank at the start, drifted out on the first turn and trailed throughout staying well off the rail.
