GOING YARD moved outside on the turn, raced five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. TANNERS WES WIN between foes entering the turn, raced in the three path into the lane and offered little in the drive. DIAMOND STORM saved ground and lacked a bid. BE MY MOBIL raced along the inside turning for home and lacked a rally. ISADORA'S PRIDE stumbled at the start, pressed inside and tired through the lane.
