NUTMEG NED set the early pace inside, was headed on the final turn, battled through the lane and finished gamely to prevail. VADER lunged out and broke inward bumping a rival, prompted the early issue, moved to the front between calls on the final turn, continued outside the top one through the lane and finished willingly. COSMIC SURFER bumped and steadied at the start, moved out on the final turn, drifted in some through midstretch and finished well. DR. BILL PUTT saved ground to the lane, eased off the inside and gained some late. MODERN GENTLEMAN saved ground and lacked the needed late response. OTTOMAN saved ground into the far turn while placed, chased and weakened in the drive. COLE IS THE MAN a bit rank briefly while inside on the clubhouse turn, raced in good position into the far turn and weakened. VINDICATE IT lunged out at the break and seven wide into the first turn, chased outside, raced in the three path turning for home and tired. STONERIDGE ROCKET four wide early, raced near the inside into the far turn and lacked a response. PHILOLOGY five wide early, lacked a bid then tired through the lane.
